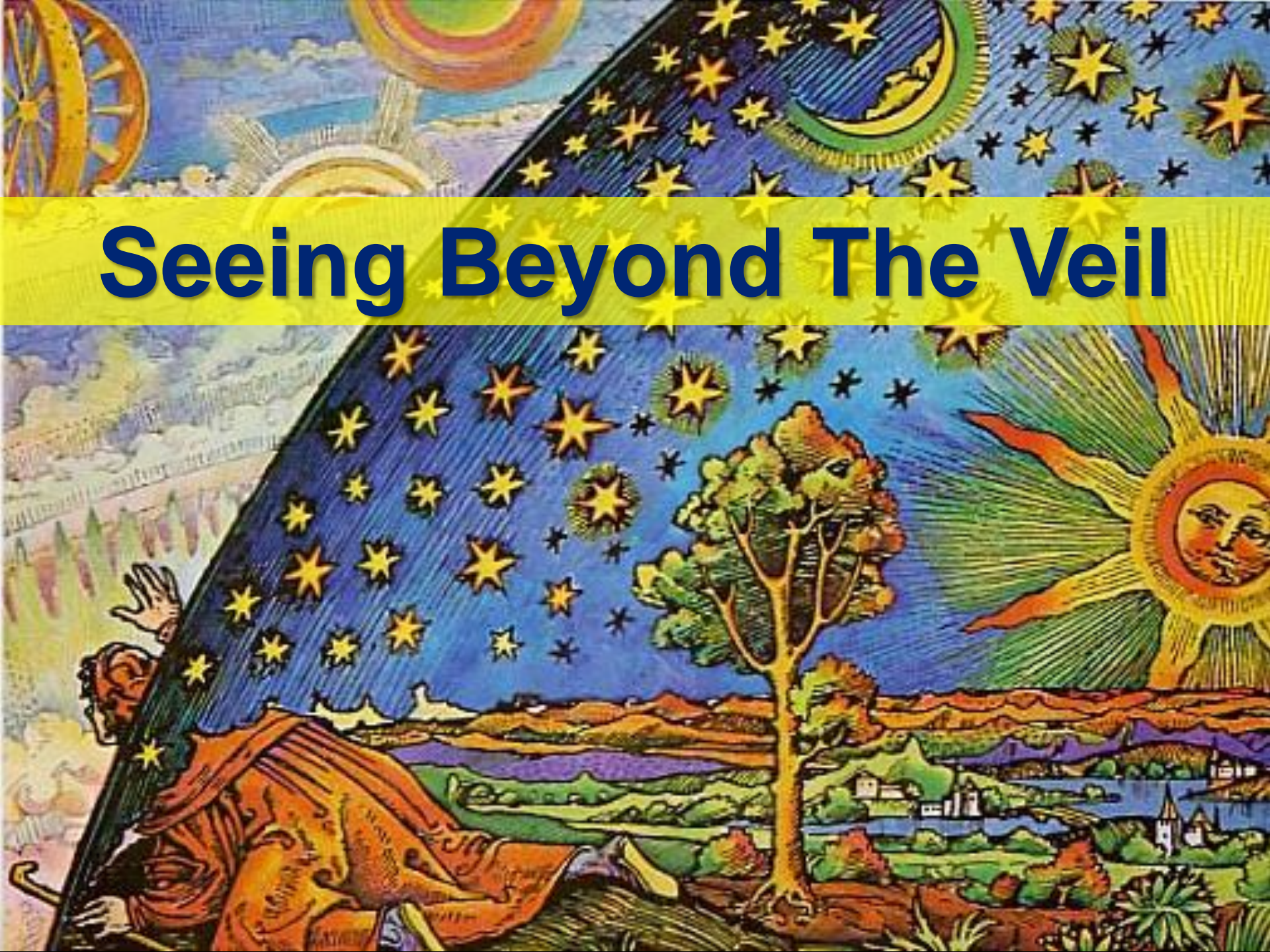

"Alchemy is accomplished by changing the frequency of thought, altering the harmonics of matter and applying the elements of Love to create the desired result."

Spiritual alchemy, then, is an ancient philosophy that uses the metaphor of transforming metals into gold for attaining spiritual enlightenment. It is used to achieve contentment, harmony, and awareness by liberating one's essence from one's acquired personality.

The personality contains the inauthentic part of the self, including one's beliefs, concepts, opinions, wounds, fears, and phobias. In this way, the transmutation of lead into gold functions as a metaphor for the process of self-actualization and spiritual rebirth.

The Great Work

- The process of raising the level of man has become known as The Great Work.

There are three stages to this Work:

- 1. ***The Lesser work***, also called the fore work or the purification.
- 2. ***The Greater work***, also called the Main work, the making of the Philosopher's Stone or Grand Elixir.
- 3. ***The After Work***, the projection of the Philosopher's Stone upon the lead to turn it into gold.

The Lesser Work

Is the successful completion of which is called *Luna*, is the spiritualization of man, the purified, exalted emotions that have been stabilized or sublimated - brought into the sublime. It is symbolized by the purest possible *Quicksilver*, which when completed is symbolized by Silver. It is the result of faith followed by works.

The Greater Work

- which when completed is called **Sol**, is the embodying of Spirit; an operation of the Holy Spirit which penetrates from without. It is symbolized by the purest possible **sulfur**, which when completed is symbolized by **gold**. It is the result of the preparation of the mind followed by **Grace**.

Azoth was believed to be the essential agent of transformation in alchemy. It is the name given by ancient alchemists to mercury, the animating spirit hidden in all matter that makes transmutation possible. In Alchemy, Mercury is not physical mercury.

- thrice born across the ages

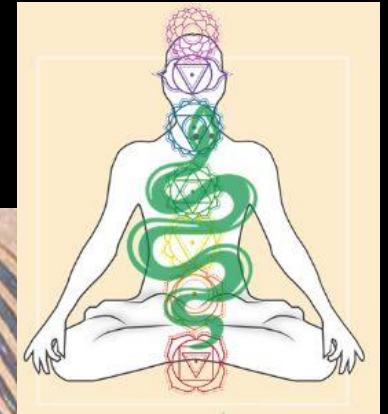
Thoth – Mercury - Hermes

The Hindu or Sanskrit name for Azoth is Kundalini. In Egyptology it is the risen Wadjet to become the Ureus

In the book of Acts, the apostles receive the Holy Spirit, and flames emerge from the tops of their heads. That is Azoth. That flame gives them the power to heal the sick, to cast out demons, to speak the word of God. That is Azoth.

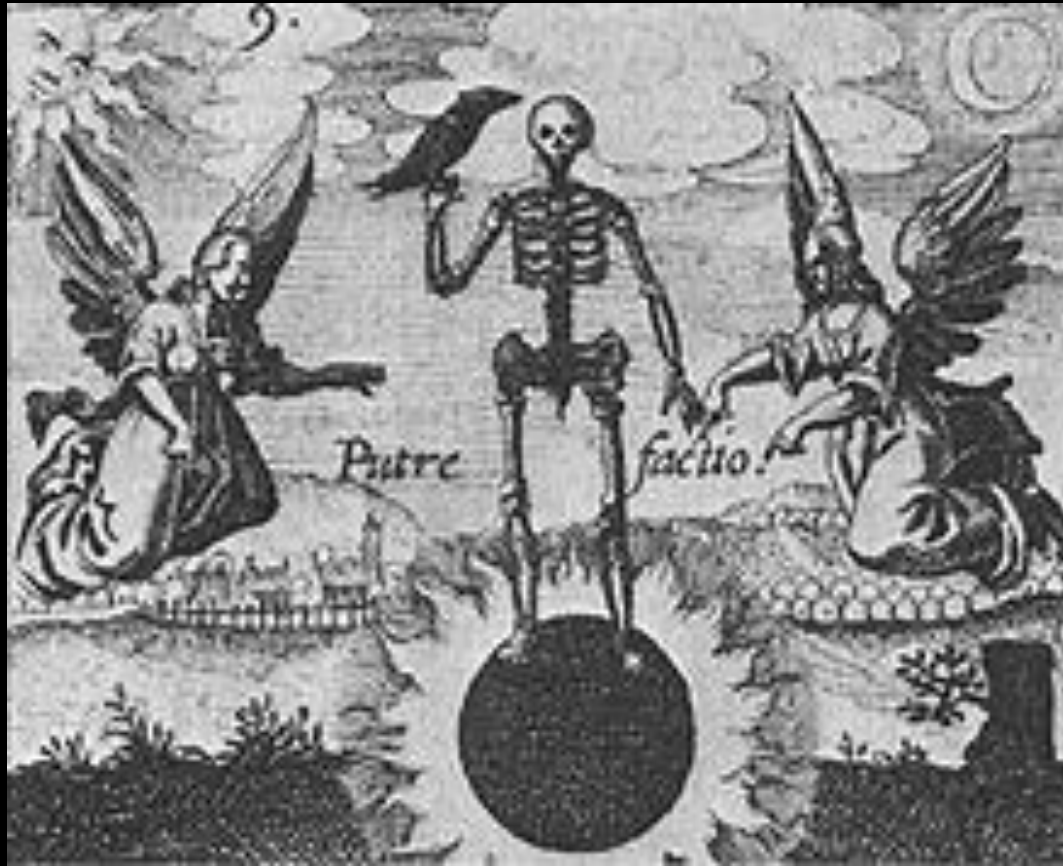

- The Black Phase is the first stage in alchemy.
- It phase begins with the operation of Calcination (Fire) and lasts through the Putrefaction stage of Fermentation. (Brimstone-Sulfur)

Hell is Fire and Brimstone



The *putrefactio* is considered to be by far the longest and most difficult phase of the *magnum opus*. It can take life times to get through. It is a time when we must let all the dross drop away. It is often known as the “dark night of the soul,” describing a time when we are forced to confront all that is dark and difficult within ourselves, and ultimately to let go of our attachment to our shadow, releasing the past.

For a change to occur in any given system destruction must precede creation; for a new order to come to power the old order must be pulled down.

This then is the work of darkness and destruction and can be the most painful and difficult stage of the Great Work.

The greatest virtues needed for the successful completion of the Negredo is skepticism.

The cold critical intelligence with which the scientist analyses his theories and models, so to the alchemist must unleash on him or herself. To gain knowledge and understanding indeed a trial by fire.



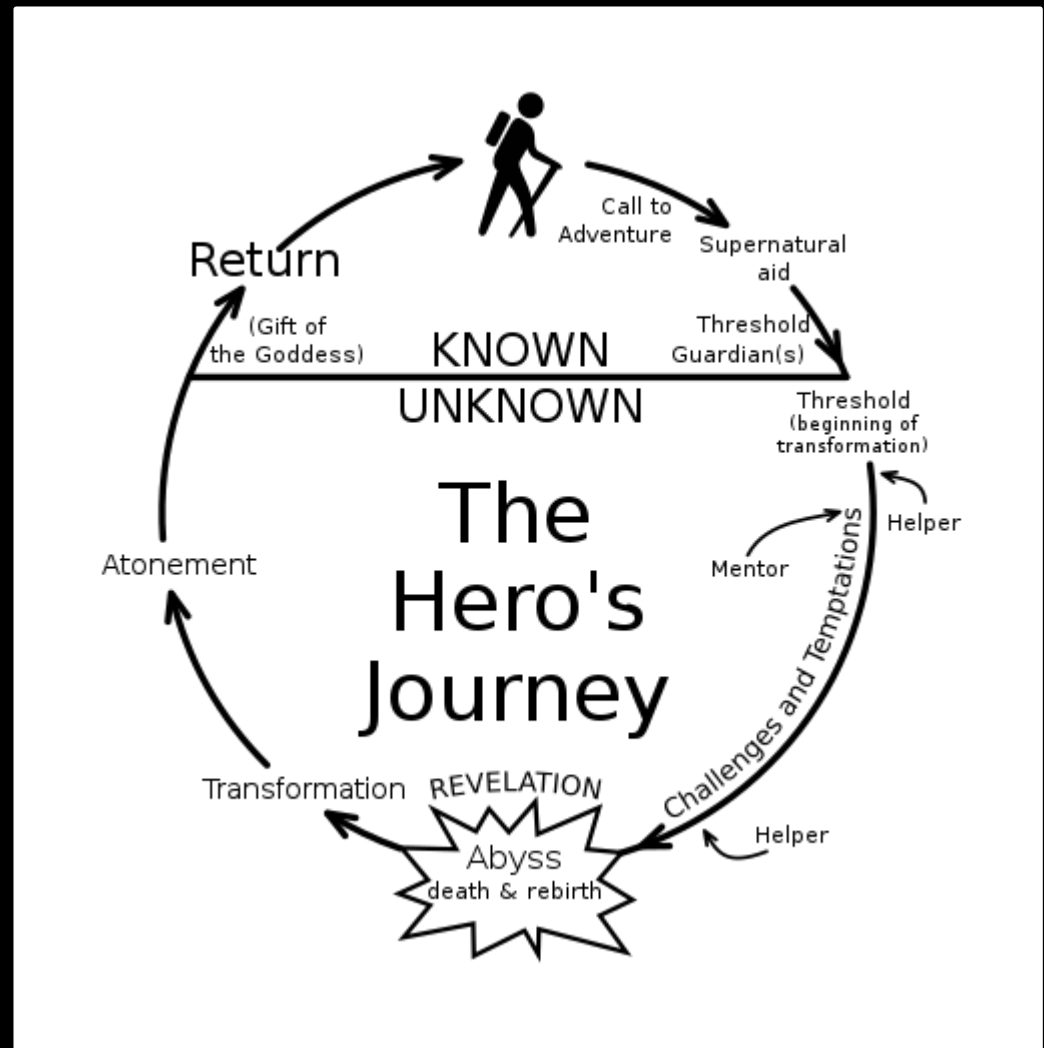



The Hero is not willing to make changes, preferring the safe haven of the Ordinary World.





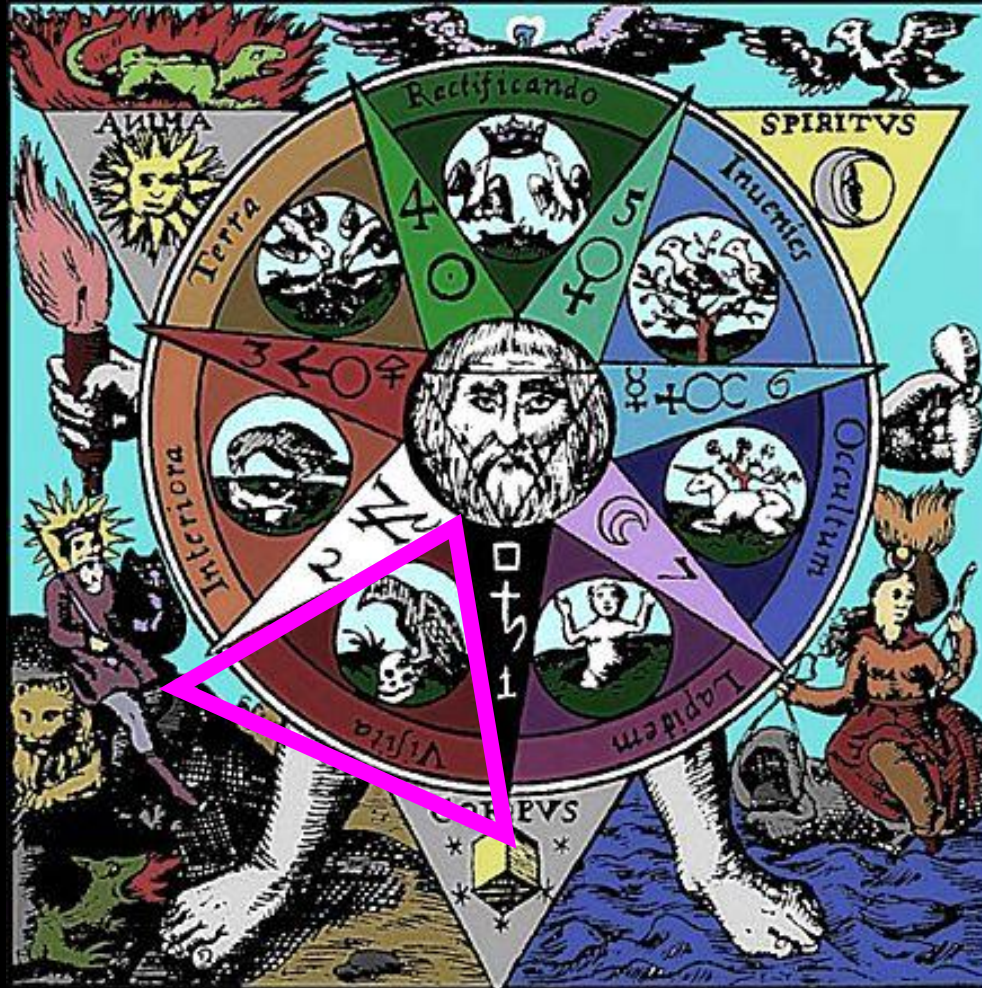

Secret 1:

An alchemical process in which a substance is heated until it is reduced to ashes.

Calcination is the beginning of the journey toward personal transformation. It is marked by suffering and despair which brings about the death of the ego.

Calcination is working with fire to burn away illusions about the self's position in the world.

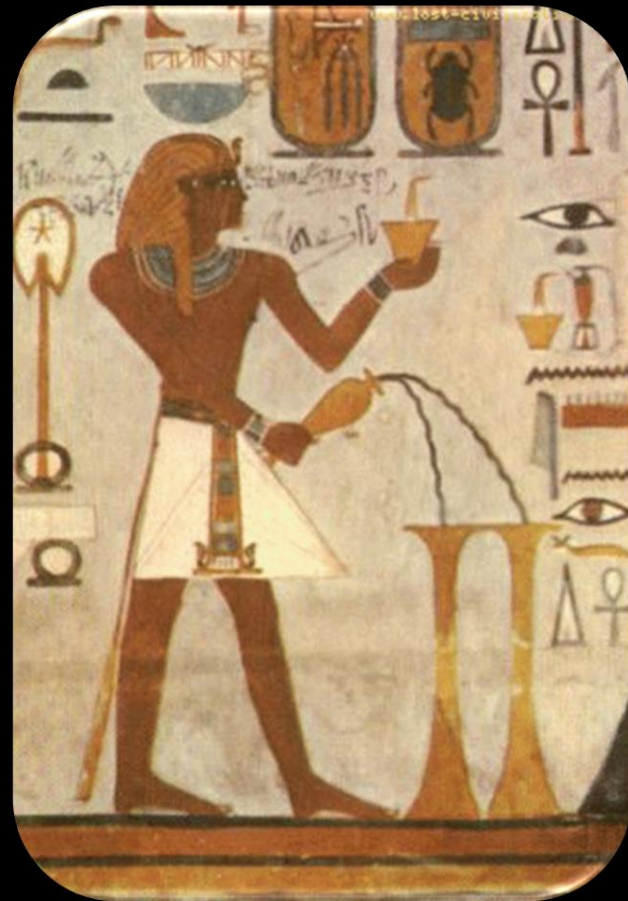
Calcination, the first stage of Spiritual Alchemy, is also known as the black stage. The color black represents chaos, that which is hidden and buried, and the material of the unconscious. It also refers to the *Materia Prima*, which is the idea in Occult science that all matter in the Universe emerged from an original, primitive base.

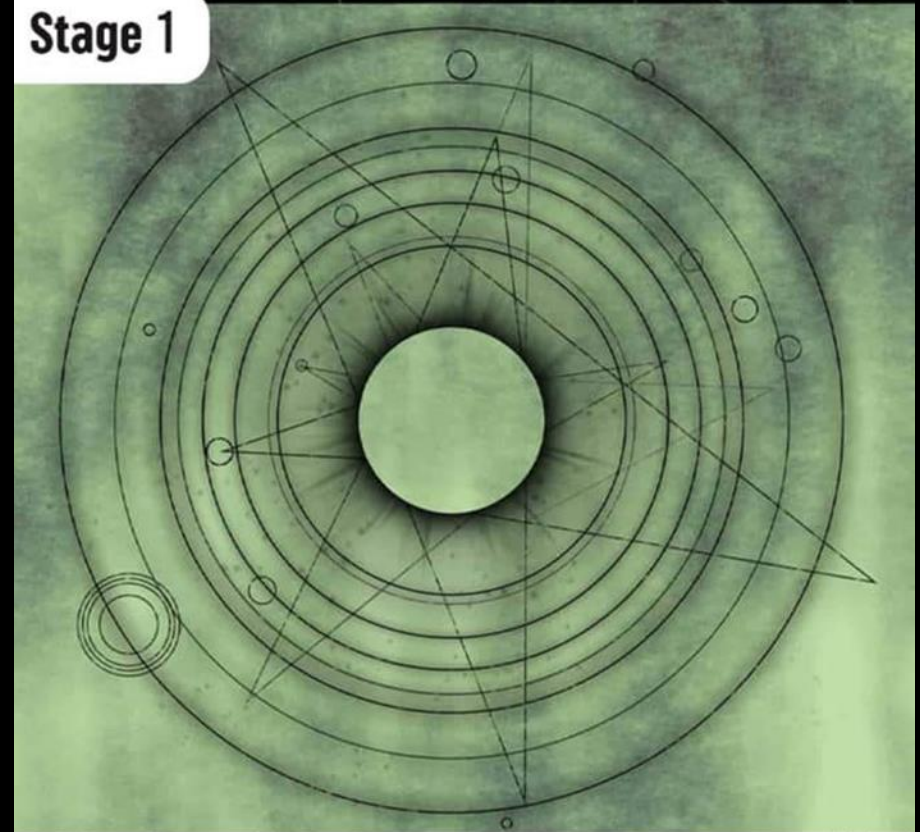

The 7 Stages of Spiritual Alchemy

Stage 1

Calcination refers to the burning of the *Materia Prima* until it is transformed into ash. In a spiritual sense, it refers to breaking with our worldly attachments, the desire for status, wealth, and the need to solidify our identity. It's not to say these things are wrong, but according to the process, the development of a higher level of consciousness and the refinement of the spirit is hindered by these attachments.



Calcination

The stage of Calcination represents the stage in our lives where we begin breaking down our egos, self-doubt, stubbornness, self-sabotaging behavior, pride, and arrogance, and put it aside so we can find out what is underneath.


Calcination also refers to the burning off of all of the superfluous elements of ourselves that no longer serve us. We are purified by fire, and the hardened and dead parts of ourselves have burned away. All that has calcified in ourselves is removed in a similar way to how hardened plaque buildup on teeth can be removed. Our preconceived notions about our identity and our beliefs are put to the test in the calcination stage. Our ideologies and neuroses begin to lessen their grip on the persona, enabling one's true spirit to awaken.



The calcination stage has been likened to the [Dark Night of The Soul](#). This sixteenth-century poem describes the journey of the Soul to unification with God, whereby our former worldview is dismantled, and we undergo a kind of existential crisis.

The beginnings of spiritual development are typically arduous since our former ties of identification are no longer valid, and we come face to face with the void.

“SUPPORT BASIS FOUNDATION”

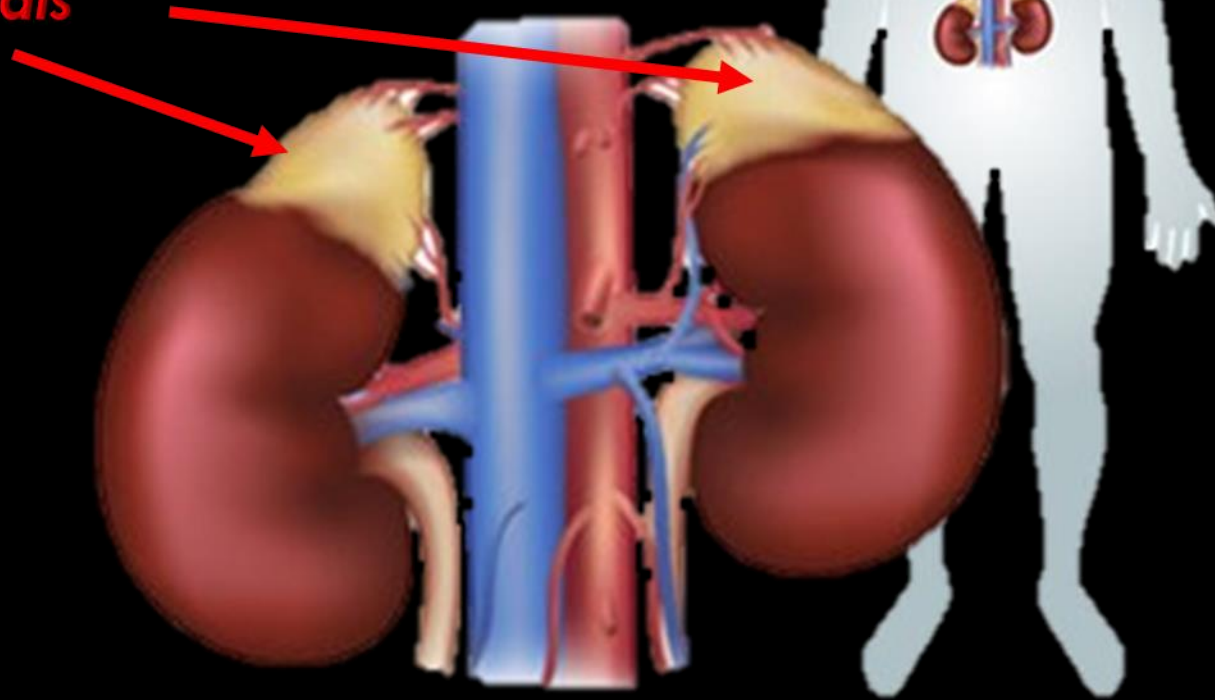
You cannot build a house without a strong foundation and the same goes for the Body House

Because it lies at the core of the entire tantric network, a root chakra that is either under or over-active can prevent a person from usefully healing the higher chakras.

Thus a healthy, balanced Muladhara chakra should be considered an absolute prerequisite for general well being.

On a physical level, the **Base Chakra** is linked to the adrenal glands whose function resonates with the “fight, flight, freeze” response. This is the instinctive survival response.

“**Self-esteem** is confidence in one's own worth or abilities . Self-esteem encompasses beliefs about oneself (for example, "I am loved", "I am worthy") as well as emotional states, such as triumph, despair, pride, and shame.^[1]

Smith and Mackie (2007) defined it by saying "The self-concept is what we think about the self; self-esteem, is the positive or negative evaluations of the self, as in how we feel about it”
