

We always have access to our UNLIMITED POTENTIAL


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
The Wheel of Fortune is about consequence.







The Wheel of Fortune is highly symbolic, more than most other cards.

Many small images are printed on the card's face, and all have figurative meanings.

Starting with the centre of the card, you'll see the focal point, the orange Wheel.

The Wheel symbolises the becoming of Reality that surrounds us

It expresses the transformations that have already occurred and those made possible by our choices or chance.



When the colour **Orange** is seen within the Tarot cards, it indicates a time or situation that will require

ACTION, INTUITION AND COURAGE.

<u>Orange</u> is a combination of the Red and Yellow Rays, and its healing power is greater than the two individual colours alone.

Orange represents

VITALITY, DYNAMIC ENERGY AND HEALTH.

Orange brings about an EMOTIONAL RELEASE OF ENERGY

Orange - Sacral Chakra. – the CENTRE OF YOUR SELF WORTH AND ABILITY TO CREATE IN THE PHYSICAL WORLD

Because <u>Orange</u> deals with our ability to procreate, the fertility of **THE EMPRESS** is linked and influenced by its' vibrancy.

The number of The Wheel of Fortune is 10.

10 is often seen as a combination of 0 and 1. Nothing and the first manifestation.

The Creator represents 10 therefore because the Creator makes something out of nothing.


X also represents both **DESTINY** and **FATE**, as well as the twists and turns of life that surprise us all.

The letters carved into the outer circle of the wheel spell out the secret to the Fool's Journey.





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The Outer Circle Represents The Material World

The outer circle contains Hebrew letters from the top right and anticlockwise –and is the unspoken name of God (the Tetragrammaton).



This is the holy fourfold name of God, which creates and sustains the Universe, and which contains within it also the four elements of earth, air, fire, and water, as well as the four court cards, princess, prince, queen and king. This is yet another symbol of change and cycles since it spirals around itself and recreates itself.

WHAT IS TETRAGRAMMATON?



TETRAGRAMMATON IS A GREEK WORD MEANING
'THE FOUR LETTERED NAME', REPRESENTING THE
NAME OF GOD IN HEBREW, YHWH. IN METAPHYSICS,
TETRAGRAMMATON IS A MATHEMATICAL EQUATION FOR
THE ESSENCE OF THE UNIVERSE. IT HAS BEEN DEPICTED
THROUGHOUT HISTORY AS A PENTAGRAM IN WHICH EACH
POINT SIGNIFIES AN ELEMENT - EARTH, WIND, FIRE,
WATER, AND SPIRIT - THE 5 ELEMENTS OF GOD AND
NATURE.

In astrology, Jupiter is associated with the principles of growth, expansion, healing, prosperity, good fortune, and miracles. Jupiter governs long-distance and foreign travel, big business and wealth, higher education, religion, and the law. It is also associated with the urge for freedom and exploration, gambling, and merrymaking.

While Jupiter is known for his generous nature, the fact that he is also connected to the Law of Attraction is equally important.

Egyptian Mythology, The Sphinx Is A Power Of Sacred Royalty And Power.

When big changes occur, such as the end of an era, the beginning of a new Astrological age, or, more individually, a period when your Spiritual advancement makes a giant jump,

Sphinx symbolism resurfaces in the collective imagination each gateway; Sphinx asks us our particular riddle to check that we are ready for the metamorphosis.

Look for extraordinary things, and you will find them. Inevitably, the Sphinx's Riddle resides in the core of our being, inspiring insight.



She is the *Self* of man, the Fool behind the veil of personality. She carries a sword, a weapon corresponding to the formative world, the middle circle, which is right before material manifestation.

She uses the right discrimination to unfold the use of the inner senses into the material world.

Yes, these inner senses exist! When this unfoldment comes, The All fills our awareness.

THE WHEEL TURNS WHILE THE SPHINX JUST IS.

Its blue colour represents memory, the subconscious mind, and now we become aware that this whole journey is really just **SELF-RECOLLECTION**.






THE INNER SENSE OF DISCERNMENT.



Partially learned and trained throughout our lives and partially inherent.

For example, most people inherently recognise basic principles of ethics and morality.





COMMON SENSE.




This sense binds all the inner and outer senses together and gives a cohesive realisation of the seen and the unseen worlds. All senses pour into the COMMON SENSE, and it uses the SENSE OF DISCERNMENT to apprehend the event and then commit it to the SENSE OF MEMORY.



SENSE OF MEMORY





is what gives us more than just a factual recollection. When a memory is activated, all senses remember what they had sensed as part of experiencing the event that was committed to the memory.



SENSE OF HALLUCINATION.



It can be thought of as a playback of the impressions upon the inner senses throughout our lives, being poured out of the inner senses into the outer senses.

A good example is dreams, which are just a different rendition of the events of the waking life.



SENSE OF IMAGINATION

is better named the **ACTIVE IMAGINATION**, which is connected to the Divine Powers.

The Divine imagines, and the creation manifests.

So also do humans: we imagine, and our creation *becomes* to the degree of the potency of our creative powers.

This creative power has a direct relationship with how realised of a person we are.

Prophetic dreams are a good example of this sense. In such dreams, when the five outer senses are exhausted, *Active Imagination* can potentially be activated like a sap of a tree.

The inspirations from the *imaginal* realm rise through the unseen and pour into the outer senses. One lucidly sees and feels significant events while the body is still and asleep.



When a person reaches a certain Spiritual Maturity, they can activate the same prophetic dream experience while awake.

The sense of **ACTIVE IMAGINATION** penetrates the **COMMON SENSE**, and one sees and hears things that are veiled to others.

The Sufis assert that ecstasy is to be experienced within such an inner journey of unveiling an inner sense of discernment and witnessing.



The Snake also symbolises the life force descending into the material world.

There is a yellow serpent descending on the left side of the wheel. Its wavy motion suggests vibration, and the yellow implies mental equilibrium, intellect and the elements Air and light. So here we have The All moving into the conditions of name and form.



It tells us that we must develop an awareness of our patterns of behaviour – where those patterns serve us well or where they chain us into endless repetitive thoughts and actions.

For example, we often try to justify our actions/thoughts/beliefs with the same old excuses.

Or we resist change out of fear of trying something new. We get into a rut, and it is worthwhile remembering that we pass our 'ruts' on to our children unless they are able to scrutinise objectively and ultimately reject our limiting beliefs.



Anubis guides Souls from the Underworld to the Overworld

Ascending the right side is the jackal-headed Egyptian God Hermes Anubis-

The jackal has an excellent sense of smell, implying a sense of discernment and discrimination. Here is the evolution of consciousness from lower to higher forms.

His ears rise above the horizontal diameter of the wheel to show that through the ability to listen from within, man is beginning to gain some knowledge of this cycle of evolution. His red colour expresses desire, courage, strength and activity.



Represents the ascension of Spirit from matter back to Divinity

Above Anubis is a segment of the wheel containing the Yod, the symbol for *Wisdom* supported by *Understanding*.

We will be moving beyond an intellectual level and requiring an organic change to our makeup. The distillation that takes place within us accomplishes the Great Work.


Here the personal ego identifies through the heart with the Ancient of Days, the Hermit.



Raziel creates a connection between you and the divine source.








The Bull is associated with the STRENGTH ENERGY, STAMINA, ENDURANCE, PROTECTION, AND AGGRESSION..

In mythology, it symbolises the *Transmitter and Guardian of Light*, who can endow human beings with infinite light and incomparably powerful power.










The open books on the Wheel of Fortune tarot card symbolise that they are conveying messages from the Divine source.

They are seated on clouds, meaning that they are divine beings themselves. And until you reach a level of Spiritual understanding, their messages are obscure to you, so you continue to face the world from your earthly senses and emotional states rather than being able to see the Higher meaning behind the event.
